



The KNM Campus Ensemble, the society Neue Musik für Alle and the international organisation CoMA – Contemporary Music for All are pleased to announce the winners of the competition "Composing for and by all – Open Score Composition Competition Berlin 2025". This was the second such competition (the first was held in 2023); professional musicians, students and amateurs were invited to compose a piece for amateur ensembles dedicated to contemporary music.

We received a total of 23 entries: from Europe, North and South America, China and Australia. The prizes were financed by *CoMA – Contemporary Music for All*, the *Klangwerkstatt Berlin – Festival für Neue Musik* and *Neue Musik für Alle*.

The jury, comprising Dr. Lorelei Dowling, Dr. Cathy Milliken and Ms. Ying Wang, selected the following winners:

1st prize: Max Wilson, "A Vision Port"

2nd prize: Brian Ledwidge Flynn, "Perpetual Motion"

3rd prize: Marco Wedel, "Gemeinsamkeiten"

A special mention also goes to Brooke Green for "Après"

The pieces will be added to the library of *CoMA – Contemporary Music for All* and will receive their première performances in November 2025 within the *KNM Campus Days* as part of the meeting *Klangwerkstatt Berlin – Festival für Neue Musik*.
